


Learning the system

- You can easily learn the system in about 60 seconds.




Learning the system




The Manx Mutation System

What is the system?



- You only need to recall some easy words.
- The system is made up of eight phrases.





The Manx Mutation System

You already know the first phrase.

“Several tired children
howling.”

Here are the rest in 60 seconds.



The Eight Phrases

- Several tired children howling
- Big muddy van
- Car key chain
- Dark giant ghost
- Poor photograph
- Quiet whistle
- Jolly youth
- Fox ox



How? The Rules:

- Recall the phrase
 - Note the initial consonant(s)
 - Last word shows the letter changes of all previous words
-
- Several **tired** **ch**ildren - **h**owling

- Conning (rabbit) - daa chonning

- **Duillag** (leaf) - daa ghuillag
- **Grian** (sun) - daa ghrian
- **Ping** (penny) - daa phing


