

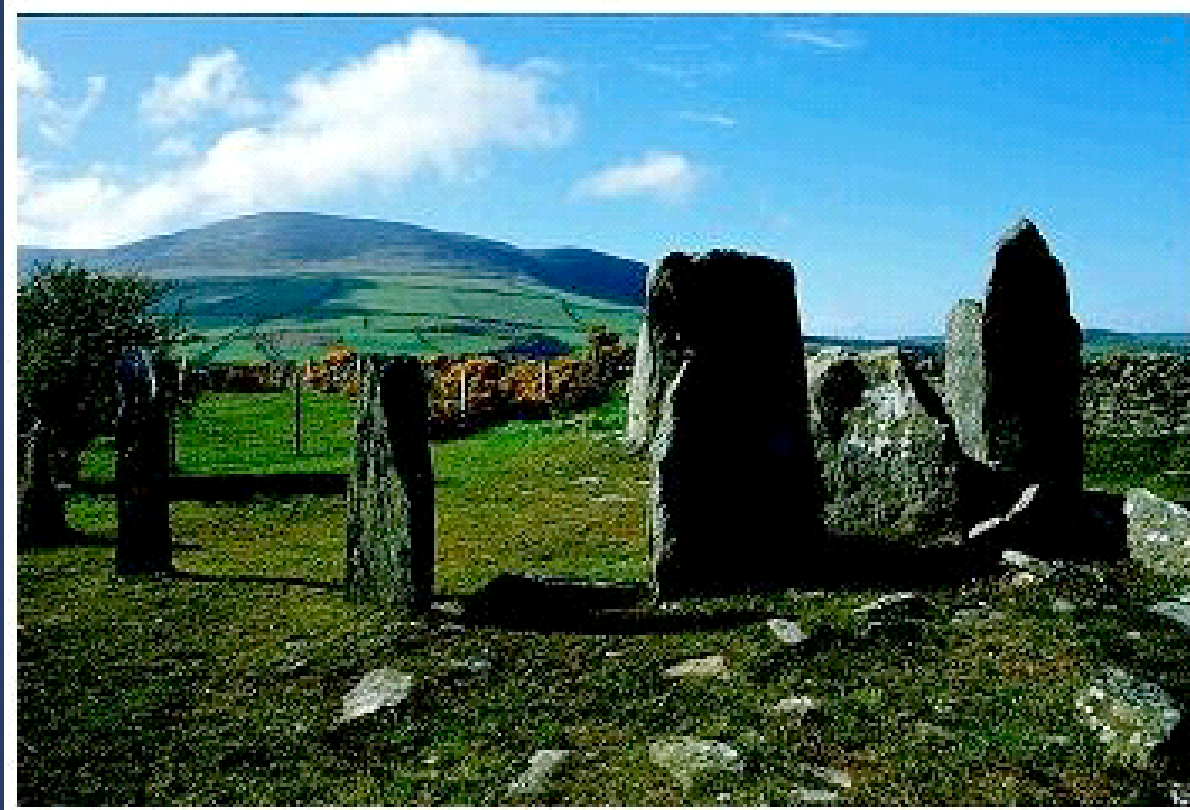

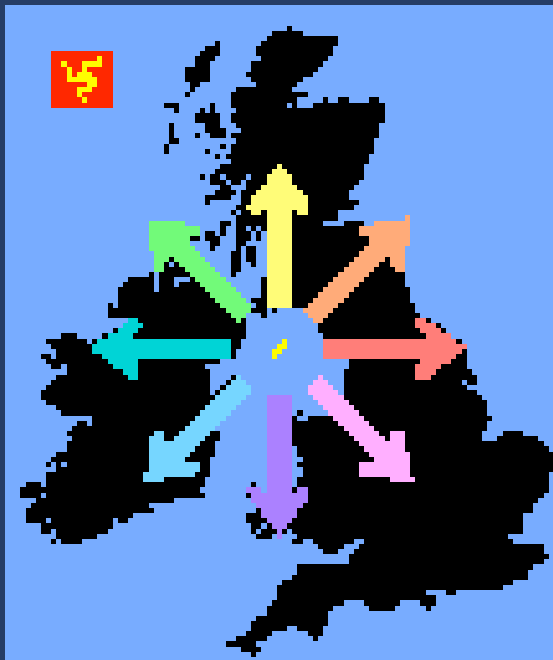

# Learning the system

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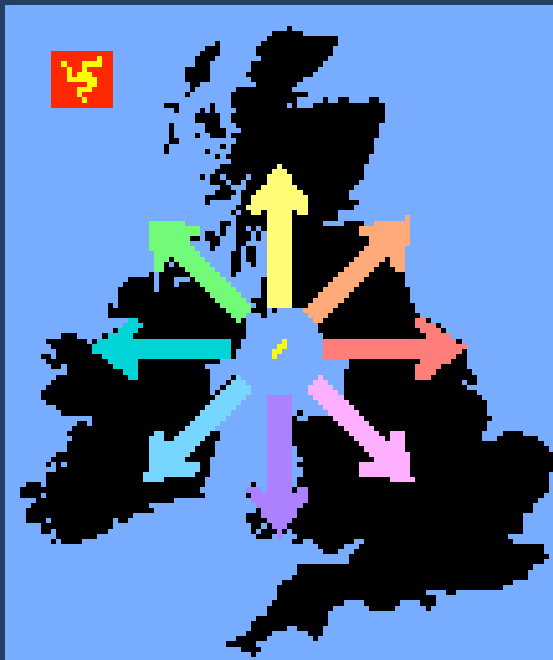


- The Manx mutation system is very simple.

# The Manx Mutation System

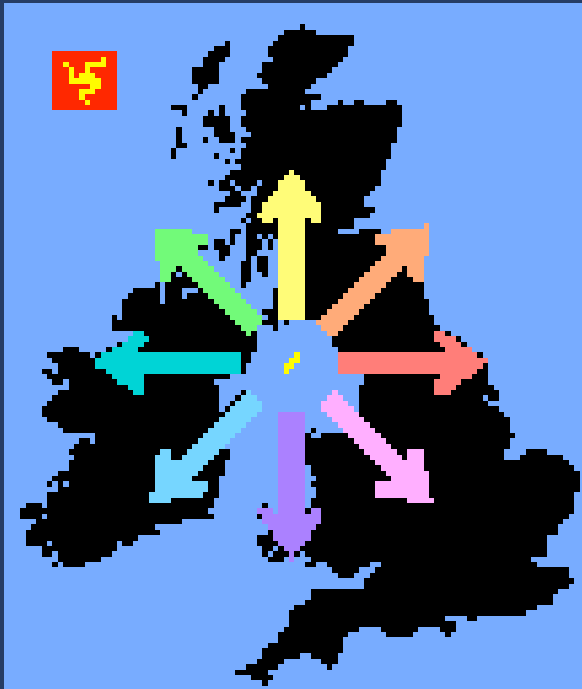
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“Several tired children howling.”

# The Eight Phrases

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- Several tired children howling
- Big muddy van
- Car key chain
- Dark giant ghost
- Poor photograph
- Quiet whistle
- Jolly youth
- Fox ox



# How? The Rules:

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- Recall the phrase
- Note the initial consonant(s)
- Last word shows the letter changes of all previous words
- **S**everal **t**ired **ch**ildren - **h**owling

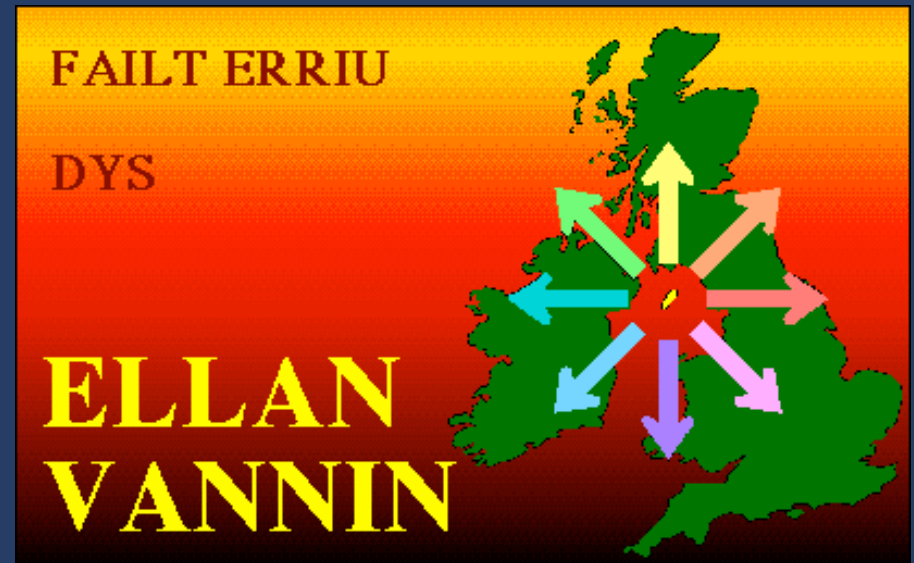

- nagh **g**ooineeagh eh? - wouldn't he remember?
- cha **g**ooineeagh eh - he would not remember

# Type N Future

Text

- Remember Stem = Cooinee!
- 
- cooinee ee - she'll remember
- gooinee ee? - will she remember?
- nagh gooinee ee? - won't she remember?
- cha gooinee ee - she won't remember

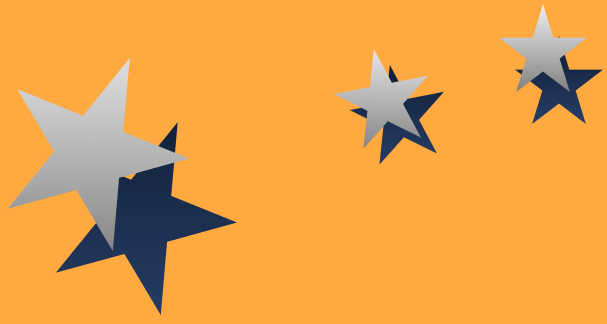
